1. On the left Browse menu, click "Regulations > Airworthiness Directives (ADs) > Emergency ADs (EAD)"

The Federal Register is the official daily publication of the United States government. As such, the FAA publishes airworthiness directives in full in the Federal Register as amendments to 14 CFR §39.13

3. To find all EADs applicable to a specific model:

When searching for all EADs applicable to a specific aircraft/engine/propeller, it is recommended to search using **ONLY** the Model field. Over time, models can be transferred to different Type Certificate Holders (manufacturers). Adding a manufacturer name to the Make field could limit the returned list of EADs.

- Click the "Model" drop down, use search field to type in the applicable model, and check the corresponding box or boxes (e.g. 737-200 Series)
- Click "Apply"
